**COUNCIL MEMBERS REPORTS:**

Councilwoman Bellinger: The Senior Center is anxiously awaiting the opportunity to expand their facility. They want their time frame for that. Mayor LaBarbiera asked if they have come up with any ideas yet. Councilwoman Bellinger says the new director is putting them in the right direction. They discussed ID cards.

Councilwoman Tedesco-Santos: No report

Councilman Garcia: Golf had two questions. The water situation with the pond expansion is not good. They also wanted to know the status of the acquisition of the County college property. They want to get going on the cart path as well. The Environmental Commission received a proposed drawing for the sign. Do they go to a sign person? Mr. D’Arco says it will be handled in the 2016 budget once the governing body reviews it. There is an issue with the composition of the Environmental commission. Paul Kaufman advises that they discuss it in closed session. Also there should be a discussion about the salary of a department head. Mr. Kaufman advises that should be in closed as well. There were some issues with a rec program. Can we get all our committee liaisons to send us agendas prior to their meetings? Mayor LaBarbiera says they can ask them to do it as a courtesy. They want to do “D Zones” at the turf field. This would increase the square footage to 20-30 thousand square feet and raise the cost as well. Councilman Garcia had a resident approach him claiming that her grandfather donated property that was used to create a bridge from Ramile Court to Besen Park. She sent some documents over from McClave & Fox. She is asking that a plaque be put on the bridge recognizing her grandfather. Mayor LaBarbiera suggests that the woman comes up with some wording and they will look into it.

**MAYOR'S REPORT:** No report.

**BOROUGH ATTORNEY'S REPORT:** No report.

**ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:** The open gym is well underway. There is a meeting coming up. Bob Cowper has been handling it and doing very well with the coordination. The last piece is the employment of security. Mayor LaBarbiera wants to point out that the point of security is that we are guests at the facility and we need to leave it in the condition that we found it. The parents and the kids have to conduct themselves the right way. Whoever does security has to be able to enforce it. We have maintenance responsibilities. Guy Picone will have a DPW employee assigned there. The Chief has been involved for the ejection of anyone who is not conducting themselves in an appropriate manner. The Paramus Art students are down to their final designs for the mural. The solar project is still in limbo. It should move along now that there are more energy grants available. 234 Spring Valley Road – we should make sure we have a deal before we invest in all the permitting. Petitioning the DEP to expand our current wells is one issue. The second is expanding the retention. There has been a company selected for the Senior Newsletter. Now a contract is needed and a draft has been sent. Councilwoman Bellinger asks who it will be mailed to. Mr. D'Arco says they are coming up with a senior list but they should start with mailing it to the town because their might be seniors living with their children or seniors who are not involved in any programs. The seniors will be getting ID cards so they can be sure that the seniors attending the programs actually live in Paramus. They can bring a guest but there has to be a Paramus senior with them. The ID cards will not give them key access in and out. The staff and the advisory board will only have key access. The Borough CFO is retiring and Mr. D'Arco will be sending recommendations for his replacement and the restructuring of the department. The lease agreement on Woodland Avenue will be discussed during closed session. The appraisal report on 113 West Midland came in. The number was \$735,000. There is a request from BC Consumer Affairs in conjunction with the Building Department to run a joint seminar at Borough Hall relative to consumer protection for residents concerning fraudulent contractors.

Mayor LaBarbiera asks Matt Corso of the Historic Commission to explain a little bit about 113 W. Midland Ave. Matt advises that it's been sold. They've been actively trying to sell it for 10 years. The surrounding neighbors purchased the property in order to prevent a major redevelopment. Their intention is to extend their backyards to take over that property. This is their third time getting together in an attempt to do this. Mayor LaBarbiera says there is still a strong interest in acquiring this property. He thinks if they reach out to those surrounding neighbors they can come up with something to achieve their objectives while also accomplishing the objectives of the Borough.

**OFFICE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL:**

Councilman Verile Police interviews will be starting first week of February. There is a meeting for rescue. Building & Grounds is working with rescue to upgrade their facility. Recreation will have its reorganization meeting January 13, 2016. Cultural Arts meeting is at the end of January.

Councilwoman Tedesco-Santos Fire had 1,262 calls in 2015. There were 49 structure fires, 21 vehicle fires, 71 extrications, 156 hazmat calls, and 14,137 man hours. They had 38 calls as of January 11. Four chiefs were sworn in – Patrick Proctor, Ken Ehrenberg, John Niland, and Kevin Joyce. On Saturday Truck 1 responded to Oradell to assist with a fatal house fire. Pool will be meeting on Thursday and will discuss hiring a new manager. The Library continued to be the busiest library in Bergen County in 2015. It is undergoing renovation and the main branch will be closed on February 25<sup>th</sup> and should conclude in May.

Councilwoman Bellinger The Senior Advisory Board met on January 4. They have a new calendar of activities. Everyone should utilize these new programs. There will be a newsletter put together that will be mailed to the homes. That should begin sometime in April. 100 flash drives were donated to the seniors to be used for emergency medical information.

Councilwoman Weber Nothing to report. Councilwoman Weber does want to ask Mayor LaBarbiera why Democratic councilmembers report on 5 or 6 committees when she only reports on 1. She wrote to Mayor LaBarbiera suggesting some commissions she would helpful on, but didn't get any of them and never heard back. She has never been Chair of any board or commission. She feels she has proven herself in the community. She would like to know how the Council members will have the time to attend all these meetings while working full time jobs. She has heard from several committees that the Council attendance is not great. She would like an explanation.

Councilman Garcia The golf course made \$2.5 million in 2015, which is their second highest year ever. The lottery for tee times is schedule for March 12<sup>th</sup>. Environmental had their reorganization meeting last night. Brian Eshak resigned from the Special Police to go to the New York City Police Department – best of luck to him.

Councilman Sullivan Absent.

Mayor LaBarbiera The Council members are working diligently on their commissions. Councilwoman Weber had a meeting scheduled last week and she wasn't able to attend. Mayor LaBarbiera wants to publicly share some information about the assignments of the council in past years. Councilman Lagana in 2012 was given zero assignments. Councilwoman Bellinger and Lagana together had maybe 5 or 6. Councilman Nazziola and Councilman Amato had 16 assignments between the two of them. Councilman Nazziola feared being in the minority but once he came to the Council that fear left him. Two years ago there was a complete reversal of the "P Party" and the constructive environment was thrown out the window. That was the beginning of the end of the partisan approach that was enjoyed in the years before that.

Councilwoman Weber brings a lot of good things to the table. She has more assignments than Councilman Lagana and Councilwoman Bellinger had combined. Councilwoman Weber has made Paramus a better place and there was thought put into her assignments. Mayor LaBarbiera will meet with Councilwoman Weber again to discuss this.

**MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC**

**Mayor LaBarbiera opens the meeting to the public for comment on agenda and non-agenda items at 8:27 P.M.**

Claudio Leo – There is a concern with Recreation regarding a second grade travel basketball program. The team is supposed to be from 2<sup>nd</sup> grade to 8<sup>th</sup> grade, and there are tryouts for those who sign up. However there are two 1<sup>st</sup> grade children on that team. The two 1<sup>st</sup> graders on the team have fathers who are assistant coaches. The intent to coach forms were submitted in September during football season. It appears that the head coach and these two first grade fathers intended on this happening. Recreation dropped the ball. Mayor LaBarbiera says it seems that Mr. Leo is correct. Councilman Garcia spoke to Bob Cowper. The brochure does say 2<sup>nd</sup> grade only. There were two spots open and they decided to let the two 1<sup>st</sup> graders on without a tryout. There is a meeting tomorrow night. Councilman Garcia says the issue should be fixed going forward. Next year the 1<sup>st</sup> grade children should be made aware that they can try out if they want to. Councilman Verile says the issue should be fixed now and not wait until next year. People who are paid as Borough employees should be held accountable for making the right decisions. It's on the agenda for the meeting tomorrow night and Councilman Verile will address it for the parents who can't attend tomorrow. Mr. Leo acknowledges that nothing can be done to change it now as the season has already begun but he would like to know how this happened. Mayor LaBarbiera would also like to know how these kids got by without anyone noticing. Mr. Leo also would like to point out that this is his fourth year volunteering to coach. Last year he was a half hour early to hand in his intent to coach form and the Rec employee would not accept his application. Mayor LaBarbiera apologized to Mr. Leo for what happened and stated that it's inexcusable.

Paula Perides – Midland School gym has several hazards for the kids who are playing sports there. The pads in front of the stage fall off very easily and behind them are thick metal strappings. There are other things at Ridge Ranch School as well that are hazardous to the kids. Councilman Garcia will bring it up at the next Board of Ed meeting.

Vivian Goldblat – This town is very enjoyable to live in. At the end of Highland Avenue at Linwood Avenue there is no traffic light, not even a blinking one. It's very congested over there during rush hour. It's difficult for anyone to safely make a turn. On the corner of Linwood and Highland there is a house that has big boulders on their property to prevent any damage if cars go off the road. There should be a traffic signal at this intersection to protect the citizens living there and traveling through. Mayor LaBarbiera says it will be looked into.

- (2) Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States;
- (3) Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy...;
- (4) Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body;
- (5) Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed;
- (6) Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of violations or possible violations of the law;

(7) Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation other than in subsection (4) herein in which the public body is, or may become a party;

Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer;


(8) Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment...;

(9) Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party as a result of an act or omission for which the responding party bears responsibility; and

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY, NEW COMMUNICATION AND SIGNAL SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT, NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT AND A NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLE, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF PARAMUS, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$2,060,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Paramus, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Paramus, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to make various public improvements and to acquire new additional or replacement equipment and machinery, new communication and signal systems equipment, new information technology equipment and a new automotive vehicle, including original apparatus and equipment, in, by and for said Borough, as more particularly described in Section 4 hereof. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Sections 1 and 4 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purposes"), the respective amounts of money hereinafter stated as the appropriation for said respective purposes. Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough.

Section 4. The several purposes hereby authorized for the financing of which said obligations are to be issued are set forth in the following "Schedule of Improvements, Purposes and Amounts" which schedule also shows (1) the amount of the appropriation and the estimated cost of each such purpose, and (2) the amount of each sum which is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance such purposes, and (3) the estimated maximum amount of bonds and notes to be issued for each such purpose, and (4) the period of usefulness of each such purpose, according to its reasonable life, computed from the date of said bonds:

Section 5. The cost of such purposes, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$104,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purposes, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 6. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$100,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purposes. The sum of \$100,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purposes.

Section 7. To finance said purposes, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,960,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 8. To finance said purposes, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,960,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 9. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said bond anticipation notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 10. It is hereby determined and declared that the average period of usefulness of said purposes, according to their reasonable lives, taking into consideration the respective amounts of bonds or notes authorized for said purposes, is a period of 11.38 years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 11. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$1,960,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this

ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 12. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purposes, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purposes, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purposes shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 13. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 14. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Sections 1 and 4 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 15. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 16. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

**DEALERS OF PRECIOUS METALS, GEMS AND SECONDHAND GOODS**

**Section 1. Purpose and Intent.**

The purpose and intent of this section is to assist law enforcement officials and victims of crime in recovering stolen precious materials, gems, gemstones and/or other articles by requiring minimum reporting, maintenance and distribution criteria for secondhand and transient dealers.

No person shall use, exercise or carry on the business, trade or occupation of buying scrap gold, old gold, silver, jewelry, home electronics/audio and visual equipment, musical instruments, telephones and telephonic equipment, scales, computers, computer hardware and software, typewriters, word processors, scanners, sporting goods of all kinds, antiques, platinum, all other precious metals, tools of all kinds, televisions, DVRs, GPS, camcorders, car stereos, gift cards, furniture, clothing or other valuable articles, hereinafter referred to as "secondhand goods or articles," or being a secondhand dealer within the Borough of Paramus without having first obtained a license from the Borough of Paramus.

**Section 2. Definitions.**

For the purposes of this section, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings ascribed herein. Words used in the present tense shall include the future, words in the plural number shall include the singular number and words in the singular number shall include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

*Acceptable identification* shall mean acceptable forms of identification which include: a current valid New Jersey Driver's License or Identification Card, a current valid photo driver's license issued by another US state, a valid United States Passport, or other verifiable US government issued identification.

*Article* shall mean any article of merchandise, including any portion of such article, whether a distinct part thereof or not, including every part thereof whether separable or not, and also including material for manufacture. And as so defined in N.J.S.A. 51:6-1.

*Chief of Police* shall mean the Chief of Police of the Borough of Paramus or his designee/representative.

*Database* shall mean a computerized interne capable database with hardware and software compliant to that set by the Chief of Police.

*Dealer* shall mean any person, partnership, corporation, or other entity, whether permanent or itinerant, who on one or more occasions (through any means) buys or sells or otherwise exchanges or trades secondhand gold, silver, precious metals, gems, or jewelry, and includes anyone advertising the purchase or sale of any of the aforementioned items.

*Designated vendor* shall mean a person or entity that is appointed or designated by the Chief of Police who is authorized to collect and maintain precious metal transaction information, or other purchase information as defined herein, for the Borough of Paramus.

*Gift card* shall mean a restricted monetary equivalent or script that is issued by retailers or banks to be used as an alternative to a non-monetary gift.

*Itinerant business* shall mean any business conducted intermittently within the Borough of Paramus or at varying locations.

*Person* shall mean any individual natural person, partnership, joint venture, business, society, associate, club, trustee, trust, corporation, or unincorporated group, or an officer, agent, employee, servant, factor or any form of personal representative of any thereof, in any capacity, acting for self or on behalf of another.

*Precious metals* shall be comprised of gold, silver, platinum and/or their alloys as defined in N.J.S.A. 51:5-1 et seq., N.J.S.A. 51:6-1 et seq., and/or N.J.S.A. 51:6A-1 et seq.; gems, gemstones, coins and all forms of jewelry herein contained.

*Public* shall mean individuals and retail sellers, not to include wholesale transactions or transactions between other merchants.

*Purchase* shall mean the exchange of money and the exchange, deposit, pledge, sale, conveyance or trade of any tangible or intangible article.

*Reportable transaction* shall mean every transaction conducted by a dealer in which precious metals, or other tangible property, are purchased or exchanged from or with the public.

*Secondhand goods* shall mean any article previously sold, acquired, exchanged, conveyed, traded or otherwise formerly owned, including but not limited to scrap gold, old gold, silver, jewelry, home electronics/audio and visual equipment, telephones and telephonic equipment, scales, computers, computer hardware and software, coins, electronic tablets, cameras, scanners, sporting goods of all kinds, antiques, platinum, all other precious metals, tools of all kinds, televisions, DVRs, GPS, camcorders, car stereos, gift cards, furniture, clothing or other valuable articles.

*Transient buyer* shall mean a dealer who has not been in any retail business continuously for at least six (6) months at any address in the municipality where the dealer is required to register or who intends to close out or discontinue all retail business in the Borough of Paramus within six (6) months. Or as so defined in N.J.S.A 51:6A-5 and N.J.A.C. 13:47C-1.1.

**Section 3. Application and Issuance of License.**

*a. Initial License Application Process.*

Every dealer intending on conducting business with the jurisdiction of the Borough of Paramus shall first make application to the Municipal Clerk and shall set forth the name and address of dealer, his or her age, whether or not he or she is a citizen of the United States and whether or not he or she has been convicted of a crime, the place of conviction, and the date thereof.

A dealer of precious metals, gems or gemstones or second hand goods shall, prior to buying, attempting to buy or offering to buy shall be required to be fingerprinted and shall consent to an investigation of the applicant's moral character and business responsibility as deemed necessary, by the Paramus Police Department for the protection of the public welfare. In the event that the dealer is a business entity other than a sole proprietorship, the officers in a corporation or the partners in a partnership, or limited partnership, shall be deemed to be the applicant(s) who shall be fingerprinted and investigated in accordance with this section.

Upon initial application to the Municipal Clerk, each dealer shall be provided with an application prescribed by the Paramus Police Department and shall provide the following information on said application:

1. Name and address of dealer;
2. Address from which dealer shall conduct business;
3. Copy of valid zoning and/or construction permits from the Borough of Paramus;
4. Proof that dealer has obtained computer equipment and software required in section 6 of this Ordinance, for purposes of reporting all transaction data in electronic format to the Paramus Police Department.

*b. Contingency.* Upon completion of the investigation, the Chief of Police shall either approve or deny the license based upon the results of the Paramus Police Department investigation. No license shall be issued without the approval of the Chief of Police or his or her designee.

*c. Renewal*

All renewal applications are to be received in the clerk's office no later than January 10<sup>th</sup> of each year. In the event that the dealer is a business entity other than a sole proprietorship, if the business entity took on a new officer(s) or partner(s) within the preceding year, the new officer(s) / partner(s) shall be deemed to be the applicant(s) who shall be fingerprinted and investigated in accordance with section "a. *Initial License Application Process.*"

In the event a Dealer fails to file a renewal application by January 31" of each year, the applicant will be assessed a fifty (\$50.00) dollar penalty.

In the event a Dealer fails to file a renewal application after January 31' and after receiving notice by the Paramus Police Department and given 10 business days to file such renewal application, the Dealer license may be revoked following the process as outlined in Section 5 of this Ordinance.

**Section 4. License Fees; Nontransferability.**

- a. Each application for a dealer of secondhand goods license shall be accompanied by an annual fee of three hundred (\$300.00) dollars payable to the Municipal Clerk by January 10th annually.
- b. A license issued under the provisions of this section shall not be transferable and shall terminate on December 31st of the year in which said license is issued.
- c. No license fee shall be pro-rated.

**Section 5. Revocation of License.**

a. Licenses issued under the provisions of this section may be revoked by the Chief of Police after a hearing upon notice to the applicant for any of the following causes:

1. Fraud, misrepresentation, or false statement contained in the application for license;
2. Fraud, misrepresentation, or false statement made in the course of carrying on the business of purchasing secondhand precious metals, gems, and jewelry;
3. Any violation of this section;
4. Conviction of any crime or disorderly persons offense involving moral turpitude; and
5. Conducting the business of soliciting or canvassing in an unlawful manner or in such a manner as to constitute a breach of the peace or to constitute a menace to the health, safety, or general welfare of the public.

b. Notice of the hearing for revocation of a license shall be given in writing, setting forth specifically the grounds of complaint and the time and place of hearing. Such notice shall be mailed, postage prepaid, to the licensee at his last known address at least five (5) days prior to the date set for the hearing.

**Section 6. Dealers' Responsibilities, Requirements and Record Keeping.**

Every dealer within the Borough of Paramus shall, upon the purchase of any precious metals, or second hand goods from the public, be required to do as follows:

a. Record on a numbered receipt the name, address and telephone number of the purchaser; the name, address and telephone number of the seller or sellers; the time and date of the transaction; the net weight in terms of pounds Troy, pennyweight (Troy) or kilograms/grams of the precious metals; fineness in terms of karats for gold, and sterling or coin for silver, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 51:5-1 et seq., and N.J.S.A. 51:6-1 et seq. This information is to be documented through use of an electronic database software system as designated by the Chief of Police. These records shall be subject to the inspection of any sworn police officer of the State of New Jersey.

b. Through the use of applicably required computer equipment, and using the electronic format approved by the Chief of Police, enter all transaction into the electronic database within twenty four (24) hours from the date of purchase. The information entered will contain the information in subsection 6a. above, plus the following:

1. A physical description of the seller;

2. The receipt number;
3. A full description of the item or items purchased, including but not limited to, marks, numbers, dates, sizes, shapes, initials, monograms and serial numbers.
4. The price paid for the item;
5. The form must be signed by the seller;
6. The form must be legibly initialed by the clerk or the dealer who made the transaction so as to readily identify that individual.
7. A color photograph or color image of the seller's presented identification.
8. A color photograph or color image of all items sold. When photographing or imaging all items must be positioned in a manner that makes them readily and easily identifiable.

c. All precious metals, articles and secondhand goods are to be made available for inspection by the Chief of Police of the Borough of Paramus for a period of fourteen (14) days from the date the information required above is received by the Chief of Police on the approved form. The precious metals shall remain in the same condition as when purchased and shall not be changed, modified, melted or disposed of by the purchaser until the fourteen-day period has expired. During this fourteen day period, the precious metals shall be placed in public view at the purchaser's place of business.

d. In the event a database failure, or dealer's computer equipment malfunction, all transaction information is required to be submitted on paper forms approved by the Chief of Police. In the event that paper forms are used, the dealer is responsible to enter all transaction information into the database as soon as possible upon the dealer's equipment being repaired or replaced, or the database coming back into service. Failure by the dealer to properly maintain computer equipment in a reasonable fashion, or failure by the dealer to replace faulty computer equipment, may result in the dealer being cited for a violation of the ordinance and subsequently being subject to the penalties for doing so.

e. Dealer payment to the sellers in cash shall be limited to two (2) transactions during a seven (7) day period for the same seller. The seven (7) day period will commence on the day of the first transaction and end seven (7) days after the transaction, i.e. if transaction #1 occurs on Monday the seven (7) day period ends on Sunday. Furthermore, no cash payments shall be made to the same sellers who make more than five (5) transactions in any given thirty (30) day period. Sellers making transactions over the number of prescribed weekly and monthly periods will be paid by the dealer by means of a bank check drawn from the dealer's business account.

f. It shall be the requisite duty of every dealer, and of every person in the dealer's employ, to admit to the premises during business hours any sworn police officer of the State of New Jersey to examine any database, book, ledger, or any other record on the premises relating to the purchase of precious metals from the public, as well as the articles purchased or received, and to take possession of any article known by the police officer or official to be missing or to have been stolen, or where the officer or official has probable cause to believe the article is missing or stolen.

**Section 7. Nonapplicability.**

This section shall not apply to purchases made by jewelers or other dealers from wholesalers or other suppliers, but shall only apply to those purchases made from the public or other retail purchases.

The dealer shall keep records of all wholesale purchases for a period of 5 years from the date of such purchase, which records shall be opened to investigation by the Paramus Police Department.

**Section 8. Purchases from Minors.**

No dealer within the Borough of Paramus shall purchase any precious metals from any person under the age of eighteen (18) years.

**Section 9. Violations and Penalties.**

Violation of any provision of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars for a first offense, one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars for a second offense, and three thousand (\$3,000.00) dollars for a third offense or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding ninety (90) days or by a period of community service not exceeding ninety (90) days. Each and every violation shall be considered a separate violation. Every day that a violation continues shall be a separate violation. Each violation shall result in an additional ten (10) day suspension. Any person who is convicted of violating the provisions of this Chapter within one year of the date of a previous violation and who was fined for the previous violation may be sentenced by the Court to an additional fine as a repeat offender. The additional fine imposed as a repeat offender shall not be less than the minimum or exceed the maximum fine provided herein, and same shall be calculated separately from the fine imposed for the violation of this section.

**WHEREAS**, the Borough previously entered into a professional services agreement with Tax Counsel to represent the Borough in all commercial tax appeals for a fee not to exceed One Hundred and Fifty Thousand and 00/100ths (\$150,000.00) Dollars (the "Cap"); and

**WHEREAS** due to extensive litigation and over seventy (70) tax appeals filed against the Borough, Tax Counsel has spent additional time and resources, beyond the anticipated work in connection with commercial tax appeals; and

**WHEREAS**, it is vital to the tax base that the Borough defend commercial tax appeals; and

**WHEREAS**, Tax Counsel has estimated that the fees incurred but not invoiced for defending tax appeals during the year 2015 are estimated to be approximately to be Twenty Seven Thousand and 00/100ths (\$27,000.00) Dollars in excess of the Cap; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the Borough to increase the Cap on Tax Counsel's fees by Twenty Seven Thousand and 00/100ths (\$27,000.00) Dollars to pay for the additional fees incurred in defending commercial tax appeals.
