**BOROUGH CLERK’S REPORT:**

**BOROUGH ATTORNEY’S REPORT:**

**COUNCIL MEMBERS REPORTS:**

Councilwoman Bellinger: There was a parking issue at the Senior Center that is now taken care of. The Planning Board had a meeting last night.

Councilwoman Tedesco-Santos: The Pool Commission is interviewing for assistant managers. The Library is waiting to start renovations. Chamber of Commerce Taste of Paramus and Beyond is April 12, 2016 from 6-8 P.M. and it’s \$35.

Councilman Garcia: Environmental needs the \$895 for the stainless steel water bottles they will be distributing at Earth Day. Golf - March 12 is the drawing for weekend tee times. March 19 is the pancake breakfast. April 16 is opening day. Maintenance of sports fields and facilities is discussed.

Councilman Verile: There will be a VA Claims Clinic at the Elks Lodge for any veterans who have any problems or need to file a new claim. Money needs to be raised for the Cultural Arts concerts. Two major sponsors, Valley Health Systems and Berkeley College already donated. There is a Recreation awards dinner in March at the Florentine Gardens.

Councilman Sullivan: No report.

Councilwoman Weber: Absent.

**MAYOR’S REPORT:** Mayor LaBarbiera appoints Josie Giugliano to the unexpired term of Brian Niland for the Recreation Commission, and appoints Paula Perides to the vacancy of Josie Giugliano. He also appoints Chris Clark to the alternate vacancy for the Historic Commission.

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Councilman Verile says Monday nights are too hectic for him with Rescue, Board of Health, and work. Currently he is the Chair of Board of Health and Councilwoman Weber is a member. Mayor LaBarbiera suggests switching so that Councilwoman Weber is the Chair and Councilman Verile is the member – and asks for a motion for the switch.

Mayor LaBarbiera points out that upon approval of the Consent Agenda for tonight's meeting, 6 new police officers will be sworn in to the Paramus Police Department tomorrow. One of the new officers will be sworn in via Skype as he is in Arizona on deployment. Out of the six new officers, two of them are veterans.

**ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:** The Rec center art work looks good. The solar usage location study is still in the mix. The applications are still in the process for the pond expansion at the golf course. The energy generator plan is still being finalized. There are no plans as of now for 234 Spring Valley Road as we are still working on the budget. There is no urgency to proceed yet with that property. The life insurance policies are completed for the volunteer groups. The Besen Park bridge dedication has had a minor change in the language because that original bridge has been rebuilt. There will still be a dedication to the resident who helped design the original bridge. The PSE&G lease agreement for Woodland Avenue is completed and we look forward to the revenue coming in for that. The pedestrian crossing signs by the schools will be in the budget. There will be no speed tables. The Police Department is still under construction. The collapsed wall was authorized. The contractor is eating all the cost on the extensions. Any additional items are going to be the contractor's responsibility. The Fire Department is lending an older ladder truck to the City of Englewood Fire Department. There is a plan to donate that fire truck to the Bergen Fire Academy when it comes back from Englewood. It is recommended that the Pool Concession agreement be extended for one year. Guy Picone can address the OEM stipends. They are requesting stipends similar to the other volunteers who get a \$500 stipend. There will be no cost to the Borough on this. Mayor LaBarbiera asks what would be the basis for the stipends. Guy explains they would mirror off the Fire stipends – a 40 percent monthly attendance and 80 percent of the meetings out of the year. There is an agreement from Bergen County for fire foam donation. It is recommended by the Fire Department that we participate in the program. The Police Department sent over a traffic request for Klaus avenue making it a through street so they can then facilitate a stop sign. That request will be sent over to Paul's office so it can be drafted for the next meeting. There was a budget meeting with the auditor and the CFO on the preliminary draft of the 2016 budget. The preliminary budget can be adjusted for adoption. There is another meeting coming up on Thursday. The employee handbook should be adopted by resolution, not ordinance. Borough Attorney Paul Kaufman suggests rescinding the ordinance and adopting a resolution. 113 West Midland Avenue will be discussed in closed session.

Comments will be made at the public portion of tonight's Public Meeting in the Council Chambers.

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

**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF PARAMUS TO ENTER  
CLOSED SESSION PURSUANT TO THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT**

**Whereas**, the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-1, et seq., requires meetings of public bodies to be open to the public, with certain limited exceptions; and

**Whereas**, such exceptions include:

(1) Any matter which, by express provision of federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of subsection a. of this section;

(2) Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States;

(3) Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy...;

(4) Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body;

(5) Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed;

(6) Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of violations or possible violations of the law;

(7) Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation other than in subsection (4) herein in which the public body is, or may become a party;

Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer;

(8) Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment...;

(9) Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party as a result of an act or omission for which the responding party bears responsibility; and

Whereas, the Governing Body will enter closed session on **March 8, 2016** to discuss the following matters, consistent with exceptions above:

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY, NEW COMMUNICATION AND SIGNAL SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT, NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT AND A NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLE, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF PARAMUS, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$2,060,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Paramus, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Paramus, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to make various public improvements and to acquire new additional or replacement equipment and machinery, new communication and signal systems equipment, new information technology equipment and a new automotive vehicle, including original apparatus and equipment, in, by and for said Borough, as more particularly described in Section 4 hereof. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Sections 1 and 4 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purposes"), the respective amounts of money hereinafter stated as the appropriation for said respective purposes. Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough.

Section 4. The several purposes hereby authorized for the financing of which said obligations are to be issued are set forth in the following "Schedule of Improvements, Purposes and Amounts" which schedule also shows (1) the amount of the appropriation and the estimated cost of each such purpose, and (2) the amount of each sum which is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance such purposes, and (3) the estimated maximum amount of bonds and notes to be issued for each such purpose, and (4) the period of usefulness of each such purpose, according to its reasonable life, computed from the date of said bonds:

The cost of such purposes, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$104,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purposes, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 6. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$100,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purposes. The sum of \$100,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purposes.

Section 7. To finance said purposes, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,960,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 8. To finance said purposes, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,960,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 9. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said bond anticipation notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 10. It is hereby determined and declared that the average period of usefulness of said purposes, according to their reasonable lives, taking into consideration the respective amounts of bonds or notes authorized for said purposes, is a period of 11.38 years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 11. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$1,960,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this

ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 12. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purposes, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purposes, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purposes shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 13. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 14. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Sections 1 and 4 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 15. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 16. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.
