VIII. Engineers Report / Pool Manager's Report

a. Lane Reel and Lane Lines

i. On the Wish List from last year, Tim had said the pool needed a new lane reel.

ii. There are 2 lane lines that are not stored on a reel also in the storage room.

- iii. It was discussed that instead of a lane reel, a new 50 meter lane line was more important. One is currently required bungee cords to attach.
 - 1. Commission did not think they could purchase both this season. Commission will discuss with Michelle Limbacher and Commissioner England to see which is needed more.

IX. Committee Reports

a. Buildings & Grounds

- i. Keri will order the first round of chemicals for the pool.
- ii. Cubbies in the ladies locker room
 - 1. Commission has decided to go with the 12”W x 15” D x 60” H cubbies in Deep Blue. The sizes of the cubbies will vary totaling 66 cubbies and 18 ft. long.
 - a. Cubbies will arrive in 4 weeks.

iii. Hand Dryers

- 1. Keri brought in 3 estimates for Xlerator Brand Hand Dryer.
 - a. Commission decided to order 2.

iv. Lifeguard chair Umbrellas

- 1. Keri ordered the 10 new lifeguard chair umbrellas as per the April 14th meeting.

b. Snack Bar

- i. Seasonal Concession LLC has picked up the keys for the snack bar.

- i. Entertainment Committee would like to hold movie night on July 12 and August 2, rental of movie screen would be \$640 per event.
 - 1. Commission voted yes to movie night and approved the rental of the movie screens.
 - a. Keri will process the deposits for the events.

- i. New ID badges for children under 13 years of age have been ordered. They should arrive in 3 weeks.

f. Swim Team

i. Registration Dates

- 1. Swim team would like to change their registration date from Sunday June 5th to Saturday June 4th.
 - a. Commission approved the change.

ii. The Swim Team will have a vendor present at their June 18 registration date for the sizing and selling of the Pacers Team Suit.

- 1. The vendor will arrive an hour before registration to set up. They will need an outlet for the machine to apply the logo.
 - a. Commission approved the request.

iii. Several parents are interested in having “parent swim lane” during swim team practice.

1. The swim team is going to employ a lifeguard at \$10 per hour for the duration of swim team practice. They would have 24 practices (excluding June 24 & July 4). The Team would be required to put aside \$240 to pay the lifeguards.
2. The Swim Team would suggest \$25 per swim team adult who signs up. If there are less than 10 participants, the team will cover the cost and reassess the need for next year.
