- b. Letter received from Paramus Board of Education containing an approved resolution approving the 2016-2017 Budget.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

COUNCIL MEMBERS REPORTS:

Councilwoman Tedesco-Santos The pool is getting ready to open. There is a new system for holding the chairs. The library renovations will be moving along soon.

Councilman Garcia The Board of Ed voted on their budget last week. They presented an \$89 million budget which is up about \$1.5 million from last year. There is still confusion with the Master Plan and the Affordable Housing ordinance. The public information session is for the Master Plan. The lights are on at the sports complex for the basketball and tennis courts which no one is using, but not for softball and the games have to be cancelled. Golf course is on pace for the second best year in 5 years.

Councilman Verile It was a slow month for Paramus Rescue. Recreation will sell tickets for Senior Citizens Spring Fling. The Rec Department has now put together an online registration program.

Councilman Sullivan Move 16-05-382 to non-consent. The Council received a letter at 3:00 P.M. today regarding the special meeting on May 9, 2016. The letter is asking to reschedule the meeting to give it 180 more days.

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Councilwoman Weber Quality of Life had 10 notices of violation and 2 summonses issued. Board of Health rabies vaccination clinic will be May 11 and May 12. There is also a free blood pressure and diabetes screening on May 11. There will be a family wellness festival at Van Saun Park held by Community Health Improvement Plan. Councilwoman Weber inquires about the number of affordable housing units in Paramus' inventory. Why are letters regarding affordable housing not sent to council members? Councilwoman Weber references a letter she has in front of her. Borough Attorney Paul Kaufman reviews the letter and explains it to Councilwoman Weber.

Councilwoman Bellinger: Arrived late 7:35 pm.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: Budget adoption will be May 24, 2016. A resident sent in a communication about a street light. The traffic division evaluated it and it is considered dark and unlit. PSE&G will put a street light there. East Brook Turf bids came in. A meeting is coming up regarding the school crossing signs. The collapsed wall at the police department is going out to bid. The library renovation bids are out. Recreation Center remodeling is nearly complete. The school crossing guard's contract will be discussed in closed session. The PSE&G disputed bill will be discussed at an upcoming meeting. Just Pups, Inc. hearing disposition will be discussed in closed session. The hearing was scheduled for last night. There was a tentative agreement. The governing body will review a potential settlement agreement. Besen Park bridge replacement is on schedule. The state is refunding some solar projects. The golf course pond expansion is still pending. 234 Spring Valley Road is still pending. The 2015 user friendly budget has been modified and adjusted. The new one is complete and has been sent to the state and the governing body. Financial disclosure statements are due soon. The company that provides payroll for the Borough will be expanding its work which will save the Borough money. Councilman Sullivan questioned some telephone costs and expenses for our phone systems. The IT department did research on new phone systems as the phone system had been crashing. The current system saved the Borough more than \$21,000 per year on the three year contract we have. There were a lot of dead lines that the Borough was paying for. There was another meeting about the Teterboro flight path change. The flight pattern has been introduced but none of the pilots were flying that flight pattern. Mr. D'Arco sent an email stating Paramus is desirous of having noise monitors at strategic locations in the Borough so there could be a comparison on pre and post noise. 113 West Midland Avenue is on for closed session.

Councilwoman Bellinger arrived to the meeting at 7:35 P.M.

The Council discusses whether or not a member of a board or commission should be allowed to sit in on closed session if the discussion in closed session pertains to their board or commission. Councilman Garcia goes on record saying that he has no problem allowing a member of a board or commission to sit in on closed session if the items discussed pertain to their department but that it will create a precedent for others to want to sit in on closed session. Mr. Kaufman advises that if the Council believes this person can add to the discussion and assist the Council in their evaluation of the topic under discussion, then they have the right to ask that person to sit in.

A resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign the settlement has been added to the Consent Agenda (16-05-406).

Salvatore Moretti Alpine Drive – speaks about statements made at public meetings and states that he believes there are more important matters than the Just Pups settlement.

Jean Hegg 321 Lockwood Drive – Inquires about what is going to happen to the puppies that were rescued from the van. Mayor LaBarbiera says they are in possession of the Bergen County Prosecutor and that the status of the puppies is entirely separate and apart from what has been discussed tonight regarding the settlement in connection with their license.

Ms. Matahen – Third grader inquiring about lowering the height of the basketball hoops at Petruska Park.

Jean Hegg Lockwood Drive – Asks who she has to contact to get a crosswalk at Circle Drive which comes down to a school zone. Also, there is no school zone marker at From Road in front of New Alliance Academy. The food pantry is Saturday at 97 Farview Avenue from 10 AM to 2 PM. Councilwoman Weber acknowledges how informative Mrs. Hegg was at the Board of Health meeting regarding the puppy mills.

Joe Schisani 201 Brookfield Avenue – Comments on the meeting regarding the Teterboro flight pattern change. Mr. Schisani attended the meeting. He believes it was a waste of time and wants to know what Paramus will do about it.

Nick Matahen 66 Primrose Lane – inquires about moving the polling place from Memorial School to the Rec Center. Will there be any other polling places removed from schools? Whose decision is it? Mayor LaBarbiera advises that it is ultimately the decision of the County Board of Elections office to approve a polling place. Right now, the Rec Center was the only viable alternative in regards to parking, size and handicap accessibility. We will continue to search for new polling places in order to remove polling from the schools. The Board of Ed wants to reduce interaction between voters and students.

Jeff ? – Speaks about the special meeting about Affordable Housing in its relation to the impact on the schools. Suggests that a council member attends committee meetings.

Councilman Sullivan inquires about postponing the affordable housing meeting. Mayor LaBarbiera and Mr. Kaufman explain the risks associated with postponing. Mr. Sullivan feels it is being rushed and the governing body should wait until everyone understands all the information distinguishing the affordable housing issue and the master plan.

Jill Rosenfeld 624 Alberta Drive – Asks when the final version of the affordable housing ordinance will be out. Mr. Kaufman advises that it should be on the website.

Salvatore Moretti – Spoke with Boswell to get a copy of the zoning map, who advised him that he should have to fill out an OPRA request. Mr. Kaufman says the map will be made available to the public without an OPRA request.

Joe Schisani 201 Brookfield Avenue – Speaks about certain houses in the Borough looking unkempt and what Quality of Life can do about it. Mr. D'Arco comments that sanitation crews are also reporting houses to Quality of Life when they notice a problem.

**ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS
AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 0% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriations and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Paramus in the County of Bergen finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY2016 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$1,655,316.35 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Paramus, in the County of Bergen, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY2016 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Paramus shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$1,655,316.35, and that the CY2016 municipal budget for the Borough of Paramus be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

**ORDINANCE AMENDING PARAMUS CODE § 419 TO CHANGE STREET NAME FROM
"INDUSTRIAL AVENUE" TO "VALLEY HEALTH PLAZA"**

Section 1. Purpose & Authority. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, 40:49-2, and 39:4-197.5, the Paramus Governing Body hereby amends Section 419 of the Paramus Code as set forth below.

Section 2. Renaming "Industrial Avenue" to "Valley Health Plaza." Section 419-7 of the Paramus Code is hereby amended as follows. Additions are highlighted.

§ 419-56. Schedule XIV: Parking Prohibited at All Times.

In accordance with the provisions of § 419-19, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets or parts thereof:

Name of street:	Side:	Location:
Valley Health Plaza	Both	Entire length

Section 3. Repealer. All prior ordinances that are inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed. All ordinances are hereby amended to be consistent with this ordinance and all ordinances, including this one, shall be construed consistent with the express purpose of this ordinance.

Section 4. Savings and Construction. This ordinance shall be construed consistent with the purpose stated in section 1 hereof. Any ambiguities in this ordinance shall be construed in accordance with the purpose of this ordinance. If any part of this ordinance is invalidated by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall be saved to the full extent possible. This ordinance repeals provisions of the Paramus Code only where stated herein; otherwise this ordinance is amendatory and supplementary to existing provision of the Paramus Code.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and publication of notice of adoption as provided by law.

- (4) Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body;
- (5) Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed;
- (6) Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of violations or possible violations of the law;
- (7) Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation other than in subsection (4) herein in which the public body is, or may become a party;

(8) Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment...;

(9) Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party as a result of an act or omission for which the responding party bears responsibility; and
