Councilman Sullivan Put the Bills List on Non Consent. Inquires about the cap bank. Also inquires about the Golf Course Cart Path.

Councilman Garcia Shade Tree is back logged with the roots program. People should not have to wait 6 years to have their roots taken care of. Suggests going out to bid and having a contractor take care of it.

Councilwoman Weber No report.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: The sidewalk project for Shade Tree – there is a list of trees that are lifting sidewalks. Every year letters are sent to residents who contract for it themselves, and we were reimbursing residents. This is not permitted under DCA guidelines. That ended this year. We will be going out to bid for this and it will be monitored by Shade Tree. There are 220 residents waiting to have tree roots shaved and cut since 2009. We will be going out to bid for this and have it all done under the guidelines of Shade Tree. People should not be waiting years for this. It makes more sense to go out to bid.

Councilman Garcia mentions the parking situation for the kid soccer program. On Sunday mornings people park on both sides of the street. There are signs up prohibiting parking on one side. The police have started ticketing. Suggests that we shouldn't have kid's soccer at a place with poor parking.

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Mr. D'Arco referred the Chief and Traffic Lieutenant to the Police Committee regarding three school crossing locations that they want to decommission due to a very small amount of children using them. East Brook Turf bid is on. Councilwoman Bellinger inquires about the schedule of the project. Mr. D'Arco advises that it is close, but should probably be done before school opens. It is a good idea to continue tonight with the approval of the contract for that bid. The schedule of delivery for the donated score board at the Sports Plex should be coming soon. We are working on a potential score board for East Brook. The gas meter at Public Works went out which resulted in a bill of \$108,000.00. Mr. D'Arco and CFO Sheri Biondi met with PSE&G and the bill is now only \$50,000.00. The maps for the historic properties came in as requested by the Council.

The Environmental Commission asked if they could have some advertising at the Pool to promote the Farmer's Market.

Councilman Sullivan No report

Councilman Verile Memorial Day ceremony starts by Van Saun Park at 9:30. There is a ribbon cutting at 12:30 at the VIP Housing. Thank you to the Board of Education for allowing Cultural Arts to utilize the schools for setting up at the summer concerts. Paramus Police had 5,857 calls for April and 69 criminal arrests. There were 740 motor vehicle summonses issued. Paramus Police sponsored 15 students at Paramus High School Rotary Career Day. There is a tree planted at the Band Shell and at Petruska Park for Tony Bucko.

Councilwoman Tedesco-Santos The Fire Department has a memorial in front of the fire monument at 8:30 before the Memorial Day parade. They responded to 458 calls as of May 23, 2016. The department participated in the NJ/NY Firemen's Association Memorial Service on May 15. Engine 1 and Truck 1 responded to mutual aid in Washington Township. Engine 4 responded to mutual aid in Paterson. Craig and Michael Hopkins received the Passaic County 200 clubs award for saving a life while off duty. Stations 2 and 4 extinguished a school bus fire. Station 3 and 4 extinguished a chimney fire. The Pool will

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open on Saturday May 28. The Library is patiently waiting for the remodeling to begin. The bids are under review. The project is expected to take about 4 months to complete. The Library wants to thank the Life Safety and Paramus Recreation for all of their help during the process of preparing for remodeling.

Councilwoman Bellinger The Senior Activity Center will host Attorney Kimberly Patton who will discuss legal issues pertaining to senior citizens. There will be a line dancing class starting in June. The class is free. Seniors can sign up for the Spring Fest starting in June. They can also sign up for Le Mis. DPW employees will be attending HAZMAT training. Over 100 residents attended the May 21 shredding event. Paramus will enter an agreement with Maywood for the collection of recycling material. Street sweeping is in progress. 2016 road resurfacing project has been awarded. The list of streets getting paved this year will be posted on the Borough website. This year's 4th of July celebration will feature a float contest. They will continue with a bike and stroller contest along with Mr. and Ms. 4th of July. Letters went out regarding the public information sessions that will be held to discuss proposed changes to the Master Plan. It is an opportunity for the residents of the town to ask our professionals any questions they may have.

Councilwoman Weber May is Mental Health Awareness Month. There will be an awareness event at Paramus Park where participants will be writing positive features about themselves and placing them on mirrors. May is also skin cancer awareness month. The board of health is urging residents to reduce the risk of becoming infected with the Zika virus which is mosquito born and can be sexually transmitted. The virus can pose a threat to unborn children. May is also Lyme Disease awareness month. Everyone should be aware of the risks when walking through grass or past bushes. May is also national Stroke awareness month. It is the 4th leading cause of death and NJ ranks third in the number of strokes among residents. The Board of Health is offering free blood pressure and diabetes screening. A resident requested that all water fountains in public buildings be tested for lead. The Spring Valley historic corridor book has been sent to the printer for proofs. The cost will be about \$840 for 500 copies.

One concern is high school kids breaking it because it is low enough for them to reach. Tomorrow night there is a Recreation meeting and it is on the agenda to discuss the safety of it.

Jean Hegg 321 Lockwood Drive – Is there a timeline on when the traffic remodeling will be done? Mr. D'Arco advises that the final reviews were done by the police department and the funding is in place. It is in motion to be completed before schools open. Regarding the school bus fire yesterday – the emergency personnel and bus driver did a great job. There are 4 lanes of traffic every day that come in and out of East Brook. If that school bus went on fire 10 minutes earlier it would have been a disaster. We need to figure out a way to ease the traffic in that area. June 11th is the next Food Pantry collection at the Paramus Pool.

Nick Matahen 66 Primrose Lane – Inquires about the money breakdown in resolution 16-05-421 regarding the turf field at East Brook Middle School. Mr. D'Arco advises that 50% of the cost comes from the Borough and 50% from the Board of Education.

Ken Corrado 149 Spring Lane – Sent a letter to the Mayor & Council on Friday, wants to make sure everyone received it. The Council advises they received it. Mr. Corrado has not received a response. There is a concern with affordable housing regarding over developing the town. Inquires about the percentage in the Affordable Housing ordinance and if it could be made higher. Mr. Garcia advises him that there are no plans at this time to raise the percentage from 10% to 15% or 20%. The plan is to move forward with 10% and look at the possibilities after. Councilwoman Bellinger discusses the potential problems of going with a higher percentage. Mr. Garcia points out that these decisions have been made with the help of the Borough's professionals. Mr. Corrado also inquires about the "payment in lieu" option. Does this put the obligation back on the town? Mr. Garcia says the ordinance has been amended. It is the choice of the Borough. The proposed zoning map on the website is very hard to read. Can we make it more legible? Can the prior map be made available so the residents can view what the changes are? When will fact sheets be available? Councilwoman Bellinger advises that the fact sheets will be part of the public information sessions. Is it possible to provide a redline version of Ordinance 16-08? It is 120 pages. Residents want to see the change from the previous one. It is hard to go in and compare that many pages. Associate Borough Attorney Justin Santagata advises that a redline version of this ordinance wasn't made because it is an entirely new ordinance. Many people aren't home from work at the times designated for the public information sessions. It would be better to have them later at night. Councilwoman Weber wants to know whose responsibility it is to answer a resident when they write letters to Councilmembers. Mr. Garcia says anyone is free to answer them or to direct them to the

BOND ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE AN ADDITIONAL SUM OF \$430,000 FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS AT THE PARAMUS MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE IN, BY AND FOR THE GOLF COURSE UTILITY OF THE BOROUGH OF PARAMUS, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Paramus has heretofore authorized various improvements at the Paramus Municipal Golf Course in, by and for the Golf Course Utility of said Borough, consisting of: (A) renovation and construction of cart paths; (B) drainage improvements at various locations; and (C) reconstruction of the parking lot, and appropriated the sum of \$1,163,000 therefor pursuant to ordinance no. 15-37 adopted by the Borough Council of said Borough on October 27, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council now finds and determines that the additional sum of \$430,000 is required for such improvements, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Paramus, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough"), as follows:

Section 1. The additional sum of \$430,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvements

authorized by ordinance no. 15-37 adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough on October 27, 2015 (the "Prior Ordinance"). Said additional appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized by this ordinance. No down payment is required for this bond ordinance pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11(c) and 40A:2-7(h). Said improvements have been and shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof has been nor shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 2. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvements (hereinafter referred to as "purpose") is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose authorized by the Prior Ordinance is \$1,593,000, including the sum of \$1,163,000 appropriated by the Prior Ordinance and the \$430,000 appropriated by this ordinance, and (4) \$54,320 of said sum is to be provided by the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund grant appropriated by the Prior Ordinance to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$1,538,680, including the \$1,108,680 authorized by the Prior Ordinance and the \$430,000 hereinafter authorized, and (6)

the cost of such purpose includes the aggregate amount of \$100,000, including the sum of \$50,000 stated in the Prior Ordinance and the sum of \$50,000 hereby stated, which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that the Golf Course Utility would have been self-liquidating, as defined in Section 47(a) of the Local Bond Law, during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2015, had there been included in the interest and debt redemption charges for such year an amount equal to interest for one year at the rate of four and one half percentum (4 1/2%) per annum on said bonds or notes, and the amount of the first installment of serial bonds legally issuable to finance such purpose plus an amount for charges as aforesaid with respect to all bonds and notes authorized but not issued for such Golf Course Utility.

Section 4. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$430,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$430,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 6. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell

said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$430,000, but said \$430,000 shall be deducted from gross debt pursuant to Section 44(c) of the Local Bond Law and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance is permitted by an exception to the debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law as provided in Sections 47(a) and 7(h) of the Local Bond Law.

Section 9. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose (other than the County grant appropriated by the Prior Ordinance which shall be applied to the cost of such purpose, but shall not be applied to the payment of outstanding bond anticipation notes and the reduction of the amount

of bonds authorized), shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 10. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements authorized by the Prior Ordinance and described herein. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 11. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 12. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of

Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 13. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

**ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS
AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 0% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriations and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Paramus in the County of Bergen finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY2016 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$1,655,316.35 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.





WHEREAS, Christopher Righetti, Prisoner #59431 is currently incarcerated for the killing of Kim Montelaro; and

WHEREAS, Christopher Righetti has gone many times before the Parole Board of Northern State Prison. His release was denied each time, as the parole board found that Christopher Righetti was unwilling to take responsibility for abducting, assaulting and murdering Kim Montelaro; and

WHEREAS, Christopher Righetti has never shown any remorse for his crime and has made no substantial progress in addressing the issues that led him to murder Kim Montelaro and has demonstrated a substantial risk for recidivism; and

WHEREAS, Kim's family should not be made to relive this horrible crime every few years when there is a parole hearing. They are forced to travel long distances from their current residence in Florida each time there is a parole hearing for their daughter's killer. They continue to suffer unnecessarily on Christopher Righetti's account; and

WHEREAS, in addition to efforts of the Montelaro Family, the Borough of Paramus hereby supports the position that Christopher Righetti should not be granted parole and should serve out full remainder of his life sentence. If a future eligibility date is set, we urge the Board to select a date at least 35 years from now. The abduction, rape and murder of an innocent young woman is a serious crime that demands justice; and the family of Kim Montelaro should be given the peace of mind of knowing that their daughter's murderer will remain behind bars for the rest of his life, as ordered by the Court.
