**COUNCIL MEMBERS REPORTS:**

Councilwoman Bellinger June 18<sup>th</sup> at 4:30 is the Spring Fest at the Senior Activity Center. There has been a large influx of new people at the Senior Center. Relay for Life was last Friday. They raised over \$120,000.

Councilwoman Tedesco-Santos the Pool opened Memorial Day Weekend. Things are running smoothly with the new manager. You can still sign up for the pool at Borough Hall. The Library renovation will be starting soon.

Councilman Garcia The Farmer's Market starts on June 15<sup>th</sup>. There are environmentally friendly bags available for use. There are two vacancies on the Environmental Commission. Three people have expressed interest. The commission has a recommendation for the full time spot. Shade Tree planted a tree at the High School. There is a discussion about installing wells at different locations in the Borough. The turf field did not come up at the Board of Education meeting last night. Councilwoman Bellinger inquires about the time frame of the project. Councilwoman Tedesco-Santos advises that there has been a tree planted at the Pool in honor of former Councilwoman Wagner's son who passed away in May.

Councilman Verile The Cultural Arts concerts and events were raised by funds from businesses within the Borough. Information on the concerts is in the Library newsletter. Recreation is holding family square dance night on July 20<sup>th</sup> and several family skate nights. Registration for fall soccer programs is coming up at the end of June. Bricks can be purchased to honor or memorialize a veteran. There are applications available at the Veteran's Affairs office and the Clerk's office.

Councilman Sullivan Please put the Bills List on non-consent. Mr. Sullivan asks if Diane Marichal can be at the next Work Session to discuss Affordable Housing. Mr. Kaufman advises that questions should be submitted in advance as this is a very technical area. There is a discussion regarding how and when questions from the residents should be answered. Mr. Sullivan expresses that he believes there should have been a professional attorney present at the public information sessions. Councilwoman Weber believes that the public information sessions were scheduled at very inconvenient times. Councilwoman Bellinger thought attendance was great and didn't get one complaint about the times of the meetings. There were never any requests received to schedule any additional meetings.

Councilwoman Weber Discusses how to talk to children about the Orlando shooting. The Historic Commission asked about adopting the Closter Historic Preservation Code, replacing the

one we have currently. Mayor LaBarbiera and Mr. D'Arco advise this is the first they have heard of this. Associate Borough Attorney Justin Santagata advises he has a copy of the Closter ordinance but hasn't had a chance to review it yet. The Commission also wants to know the status of 113 W. Midland regarding the appraisal. Mr. D'Arco and Mr. Kaufman advise they have not received the new appraisal yet. Many residents raised concerns that their questions are not being answered. Councilwoman Weber believes Mayor LaBarbiera insulted her on social media. She feels it is irresponsible of those who are trying to push certain issues forward. She is very offended by being called a liar. The statements are unprofessional and she believes Mayor LaBarbiera owes her and certain residents an apology. Mayor LaBarbiera believes not making developers set aside ten percent is irresponsible and he stands by his statements.

Mr. Kaufman explains certain details of the Borough's Affordable Housing obligation.

The Council has a discussion regarding Mr. Sullivan's reservations with Affordable Housing.

**ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:** Library renovation bids are on tonight. The Rec Center remodeling is looking good. They attempted to move the court cases for Just Pups to another jurisdiction. Paramus did not consent. It would be preferred for the summonses to remain in our court. The Borough is evaluating companies for the security systems. There was a meeting with the PBAC and the PEMS regarding what both groups would need in a building. That project should start moving.

- a. Habitat for Humanity Fee Waiver Request – the Council has no problem waiving the fee as long as they specify the scope of work.

He also believes it started to become political. Discusses the Affordable Housing obligations for Paramus and other municipalities. Mr. Kaufman explains the "Gap Period". Mr. Kaufman also explains the incentives for builders to contribute to the obligation.

Rich Lambert 240 Hillside – The Affordable Housing issue has become political. We are losing sight of what is important. Some information the public is getting is weak. There are errors in the information. Most of it is not being explained. The residents expected one or more of the Council members and the Mayor to be present at the public information sessions. Mayor LaBarbiera explains that it would be inappropriate for the Mayor and Council to be present because it would politicize the issue. The issue is too complex to politicize.

ORDINANCE 16-19

AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE SALARY, WAGE AND COMPENSATION  
OF CERTAIN PART-TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF PARAMUS
