

Notice to Patrons of the Paramus Pool

The Paramus Lifeguards and Clerks are a wonderful group of responsible, hard working young people. It is expected that ALL patrons of the Paramus Pool will treat the staff with respect. Inappropriate behavior, arguing, bullying and other verbal abuse by patrons toward staff members will not be tolerated and may result in suspension or revocation of pool membership.

Membership to the Paramus Pool is a privilege, not a right. As such, we expect all patrons to act appropriately at the pool.

A few guidelines:

- 1. Rules will be enforced. The Rules are set by the Borough and the Pool Commission. Please do not argue with the staff members about the Rules. They do not make the Rules. They can not change the Rules or make exceptions to the Rules.**
- 2. Do not speak to lifeguards while they are on duty, especially while seated in lifeguard stands. Lifeguards must watch the swimmers and can not be distracted by patrons while on duty.**
- 3. If you believe there is an issue with the work / actions of a staff member, do NOT address the staff member directly. Please bring your issue to the attention of the Pool Manager on duty. The Manager will then address the issue with the staff member.**
- 4. Feel free to forward written complaints to the Pool Commission at municipalpool@paramusborough.org**
- 5. Pool Commission meetings are open to the public. Meeting dates are set forth on the Borough website on the “pool” link.**
