**ORDINANCE No. 17-12**

**ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING POSITION OF PARK RANGER TO THE PARAMUS  
POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**Section 1. Purpose & Authority.** Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1, 40:49-2, and 40A:9-165, the Borough of Paramus transfers the position of park ranger to the Paramus Police Department.

**Section 2. Transfer of park ranger.** The position of park ranger is currently within the Shade Tree Department. Effective immediately, the position of park ranger is transferred to the Paramus Police Department.

**Section 3. No New Rights/No Vacancies.** Unless expressly stated otherwise or required by law, this ordinance shall not create any rights that did not exist before this ordinance and this ordinance shall not be deemed to create any vacancies unless the law requires otherwise.


**Section 4. Repealer.** All prior ordinances that are inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed. All ordinances are hereby amended to be consistent with this ordinance and all ordinances, including this one, shall be construed consistent with the express purpose of this ordinance.

**Section 5. Savings and Construction.** This ordinance shall be construed consistent with the purpose stated in section 1 hereof. Any ambiguities in this ordinance shall be construed in accordance with the purpose of this ordinance. If any part of this ordinance is invalidated by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall be saved to the full extent possible. This ordinance repeals provisions of the Borough Code only where stated herein; otherwise this ordinance is amendatory and supplementary to existing provision of the Borough Code.

**Section 6. Codification.** This ordinance shall be codified as an amendment to the salary ordinance and other chapters of the Borough Code, where necessary.

**Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect August 1, 2017, and upon approval and publication of notice of adoption as provided by law.
