

**COUNTY OF BERGEN
BOROUGH OF PARAMUS
ORDINANCE 17-25**

**AN ORDINANCE TO MANDATE DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR MUNICIPAL
EMPLOYEES BY THE BOROUGH OF PARAMUS PURSUANT
TO C. 52:14-15f et. seq.**

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013 c. 28, authorizes local governments to mandate direct deposit for certain governmental employees effective after July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013 c. 28 permits governing bodies to grant exemptions on such terms and conditions as they deem necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough of Paramus, located in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey according to the following:

Section 1. All full and part time employees and elected public officials who receive compensation from the Borough of Paramus are mandated to have direct deposit of their compensation as of January 1, 2018 in accordance with Chapter 28 P.L. 2013, as defined under C.52:14-15f (b).

Section 2. If any Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the Section, paragraph subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and publication of notice of adoption as provided by law.
