**ORDINANCE AMENDING PARAMUS CODE § 393 PERTAINING TO PROVIDING
FOR A SANITARY SEWER PUMP STATION MAINTENANCE FEE
FOR NON-TAX-EXEMPT PROPERTIES**

Section 1. Purpose & Authority. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2 and N.J.S.A. 40:49-2, the Paramus Governing Body hereby amends Section 363-8.1. E.1.b of the Paramus Code to amend and clarify the methodology for calculation of the Sanitary Sewer Pump Station Maintenance Fee for non-tax-exempt properties provided for in Section 363-8.1 et seq. of the Paramus Code.

Section 2. Calculation of Sanitary Sewer Pump Station Maintenance Fees for Non-Tax-Exempt Properties. Section 363-8.1. E.1.b of the Paramus Code shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

363-8.1. E.1.b:

The Sanitary Sewer Pump Station Maintenance Fee shall then be calculated by multiplying the projected flow for any such application submitted to the Planning Board or the Zoning Board of Adjustment of the Borough of Paramus, ~~as calculated~~ which projected flow is the gallons per day flow measurement determined pursuant to §393-8.1.4(A)(1), by the sanitary sewer annual user charge as calculated for the current year pursuant to Borough of Paramus Code Chapter 363 and then multiplying that calculation by three hundred sixty-five (365) days.

Example:

Projected Gallons Per Day Flow (10 - 1BR units):	150 gpd x 10 units = 1,500 gpd
Paramus Current Year Sewer User Fee:	\$3.00/1,000 gal.
Calculation:	$\$3.00/1,000 \times 1,500 \text{ gpd} = \4.50
Based on 365 days:	$\$4.50 \times 365 = \$1,642.50$

Section 3. Repealer. All prior ordinances that are inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed. All ordinances are hereby amended to be consistent with this ordinance and all ordinances, including this one, shall be construed consistent with the express purpose of this ordinance.

Section 4. Savings and Construction. This ordinance shall be construed consistent with the purpose stated in section 1 hereof. Any ambiguities in this ordinance shall be construed in accordance with the purpose of this ordinance. If any part of this ordinance is invalidated by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall be saved to the full extent possible. This ordinance repeals provisions of the Paramus Code only were stated herein; otherwise, this ordinance is amendatory and supplementary to existing provision of the Paramus Code.
