**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2021-08 ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE TO
AMEND CHAPTER 395 ENTITLED SWIMMING POOLS, ARTICLE I ENTITLED
SWIMMING POOL FACILITIES, SECTION 5 FEES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF PARAMUS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. Severability

If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or other phrase of this ordinance is for any reason deemed to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective.

No ordinance or any item or part thereof shall take effect without the Mayor's approval under N.J.S.A. 40A:60-5(d), unless the Mayor fails to return the ordinance to the Council, as prescribed above, or unless the Borough Council, upon consideration of the ordinance following its return shall, by a vote of two-thirds (2/3rds) of all of the members of the Borough Council, resolve to override the veto. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
