ORDINANCE No. 2022-17

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 383 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF
PARAMUS TITLED "STREETS AND SIDEWALKS" BY DELETING AND REPLACING
CHAPTER 383-34 THEREOF TITLED "NOTICE TO TRIM".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Paramus, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 383 Article 34 of the Code of the Borough of Paramus is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

Whenever it shall appear to the Chief of Police or his or her designee or any other authorized personnel of the Borough of Paramus that the existence upon any land within the Borough of plant life growing within ten (10') feet of any roadway or within twenty-five (25') feet of the intersection of two (2) roadways and exceeding one and one-half (2 ½') feet in height is hazardous to the public safety or general welfare of the residents of the Borough or those using its highways or constitutes a safety hazard, the owner or tenant of any such lands shall be required to cut such plant life to a height of not more than two and one-half (2 ½') feet within ten (10) days after service of written notice from the Chief of Police requiring such trimming or cutting.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after passage and publication as provided by law.

Section 4. All other parts of Chapter 383 of the Code of the Borough of Paramus not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.
